1. Switch User
2. Other User
3. Enter:

Username: *zcas\studentID*

Password: *zcas123*

How to connect to eduroam: Android

1. On your Android device, go to Settings, then tap Wireless & networks, then Wi-Fi settings.
2. Tap [*eduroam*] (Wi-Fi SSID).
3. Make sure that for EAP method, **PEAP** is selected.
4. Tap Phase 2 authentication, and then select **MSCHAPV2**.
5. Enter:
